Course Title: CIN270Y1Y American Popular Film Since 1970

Course description: This course examines the social, cultural, industrial, commercial, and aesthetics practices associated with popular American cinema from the 1970s to the present. Topics discussed include the rise of the blockbuster and the multiplex, the roles of critic and fan, the relationship between entertainment and politics, and the notion of the “popular.”

Salary: Salary will be the stipend rate for a Sessional Lecturer I of \$14,718.14 and Sessional Lecturer II of \$15,647.70 and Sessional Lecturer III of \$16,370.70 for a full-year course inclusive of vacation pay.

Qualifications:

-MA required; PhD strongly preferred

-Also required:

- At least 5 years of experience teaching cinema at the university level, with a concentration on film history, theory, and/or analysis
- At least 5 years of experience marking undergraduate essays in cinema
- Evidence of recent teaching effectiveness
- Experience managing a team of TAs and markers

Duties of Sessional Lecturer: The Sessional Lecturer will follow the broad outline of the syllabus that has been established for the course, using any textbooks/films that may have been ordered. Revisions and/or updates to the curriculum should be discussed with the Director. He or she will lecture, grade assignments, hold office hours each week, and answer queries by email or appointment.
